

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-08

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Bainbridge Island, Washington, relating to the police civil service and amending Section 2.28.030 of the Bainbridge Island Municipal Code.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the public interest would be served by having the City Manager appoint Civil Service Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that with this change the City would continue to have a civil service system which substantially accomplishes the purposes of RCW Chapter 41.12;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.28.030 of the Bainbridge Island Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:


2.28.030 Civil service commission – Created – Composition – Appointments, terms and vacancy filling.

There is created for the administration of such civil service for the police department, a civil service commission composed of five members who shall be appointed by the ~~mayor~~ city manager of the city ~~with the concurrence of the city council~~. A person shall be considered eligible for appointment to the commission if he or she is a citizen of the United States, a resident of the city, and an elector of Kitsap County. The term of office of such civil service commission shall be four years, except that the first five members of the commission shall be appointed for different terms, as follows: three to serve for a period of four years and two to serve for a period of two years. The existing civil service commission shall be dissolved, and all positions on the commission created by the ordinance codified in this section shall be deemed vacant. In the event any civil service commissioner resigns or becomes disqualified or is removed for cause under a process adopted by city council resolution, another commissioner shall be appointed to take his place for the unexpired portion of the term.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.


