

**ORDINANCE NO. 2010-47**

**AN ORDINANCE** of the City of Bainbridge Island, Washington, relating to the official posting places for all city notices and amending Section 1.12.010 of the Bainbridge Island Municipal Code.

**WHEREAS**, the City currently requires official notices to be physically posted at various locations in the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to increase the efficiency of government operations by reducing the number of physical locations for posting and adding a requirement to post notices to the City's web site;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 1.12.010 of the Bainbridge Island Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**1.12.010 Posting places.**

Bainbridge Island City Hall, 280 Madison Avenue North, Bainbridge Island, Washington 98110 is The following public places in the city are designated as the official posting places for all city notices and other documents required by law to be posted. In addition, the city shall post all city notices and other documents required by law to be posted on the city's web site.

~~A. Bainbridge Island City Hall, 280 Madison Avenue North, Bainbridge Island, Washington 98110;~~

~~B. Bainbridge Island Chamber of Commerce, 590 Winslow Way East, Bainbridge Island, Washington 98110;~~

~~C. Washington State Ferry Passenger Terminal Building, Bainbridge Island, Washington 98110.~~

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.


