

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-40

A RESOLUTION of the City of Bainbridge Island, Washington relating to the imposition of Business License Fees by the City, and amending Section 2 of the Bainbridge Island Fee Schedule.

WHEREAS, in 1992 the City Council passed Ordinance No. 92-10 which, in part, authorized the City Council to set fees for business licenses by resolution; and

WHEREAS, at a Special City Council Meeting on October 19, 2010, the City Council passed a motion to increase business license fees to a flat \$65.00, and the Bainbridge Island Fee Schedule needs to be amended accordingly; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of the Bainbridge Island Fee Schedule is amended to read as follows:

2. BUSINESS LICENSES

REGULAR-BUSINESS LICENSE – INITIAL APPLICATION

~~(For those businesses which had gross revenue of over \$18,000 during the past 12 months or can reasonably expect to have gross revenue of over \$18,000 during the next 12 months.)~~

If License Applied for Before Business Commences	\$65.00 50.00
If License Applied for After Business Commences	\$130.00 100.00

REGULAR-BUSINESS LICENSE – RENEWAL

~~(For businesses with gross annual revenue of over \$18,000)~~

<u>If renewed</u> prior to March 1	\$65.00 25.00
<u>If renewed</u> on or after March 1	\$130.00 100.00

SMALL BUSINESS – INITIAL APPLICATION

~~(For those businesses which had gross revenue of less than \$18,000 during the past 12 months or can reasonably expect to have gross revenue of less than \$18,000 during the next 12 months.)~~

If License applied for before Business Commences	\$25.00
If License Applied for After Business Commences	\$50.00

SMALL BUSINESS – RENEWAL

~~(For businesses with gross annual revenue of less than \$18,000)~~


Prior to March 1	\$10.00
On or after March 1	\$25.00

BUSINESS – PENALTY	10% of fee per month delinquent but not more than the Initial License fee for each year owing
SPECIAL BUSINESS – AMUSEMENT GAME (BIMC 5.12. Billiard, Pool, and Foosball. License expires 12/31 of each year.)	\$25.00
SPECIAL BUSINESS – JUKEBOX (BIMC 5.28. License expires 12/31 of each year.)	\$100.00 + \$10.00/jukebox
SPECIAL BUSINESS – GAMES OF SKILL (BIMC 5.24: Includes video games. Expires 12/31 of each year)	\$25.00 + \$50.00/game
SPECIAL BUSINESS – CABARET (BIMC 5.16. Applies to businesses with live entertainment. License expires 12/31 of each year.)	\$60.00
SPECIAL BUSINESS – PENALTY (Ordinance 92.10)	10% of fee per month delinquent

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force on and after January 1, 2011.


