The excitement and commitment generated at the meeting this past Saturday pretty much summed up where we are and where we must be at this very moment.

First, if you have not carried over that commitment to make sure you will join the march on Wednesday, March 13 beginning outside T&C at 6:30pm, you must do so right now. Put it on your calendar. Click it into your cell phone reminders and anywhere else that works for you.

It is that important.

Second, even though all the speeches we heard on Saturday and discussions since underline and justify our frustrations, fears and concerns, we must be careful not to transfer them into raucous or other untimely behavior and actions on Wednesday before the Council and other people who will be there.

Our mere presence in large numbers will speak volumes by itself.

It's time to stop quoting chapters of laws and lines of regulations.

It is time to humanize the potential impact of decisions to characterize us as "non-conforming" as if we has lost our community citizenship.

It is time to translate the potential impact into human terms. Joe Honick has already prepared testimony without script to do just that.

Others should speak to those terms as well.

**BUT YOU CANNOT LEAVE IT UP TO YOUR NEIGHBORS TO DO THE JOB WEDNESDAY NIGHT. THAT WILL NOT AND CANNOT WORK. MAKE KNOWN YOUR PLAN TO JOIN OTHERS ALREADY COMMITTED. IF WE DO NOT PRODUCE THE NUMBERS TO MAKE THAT STATEMENT, ALL OUR EFFORTS WILL BE FOR NAUGHT. SIMPLE AS THAT.**

Bottom line: You must be there at T&C Wednesday and ready to join your neighbors. If you are here, you must be there, period.
