## **SMP Schedule**

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- May 8<sup>th</sup> - public hearing (no staff response or City Council discussion)
- May 15<sup>th</sup> - City Council will make any changes that are responsive to public comment
- June 12<sup>th</sup> - adoption

## **Bainbridge Draft SMP Exceeds DOE Guidelines**

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While the DOE allows local jurisdictions to enact restriction on use of the shoreline, the real issue for Bainbridge is not “can COBI restrict shoreline uses”, but “does Draft SMP exceed the DOE Guidelines requirements?”

Bainbridge’s existing SMP has worked well and has protected Bainbridge’s shoreline and the environment. It is a modern SMP and already contains nearly all the provisions now required by the DOE Guidelines.
