Dear Ms. Nightingale:

I am a resident of Bainbridge Island. While I have watched the evolving SMP process on the Island, I have not participated to date, nor have I asked questions. Frankly, I've felt that other Bainbridge residents have done an excellent job of analyzing the draft SMP, and that I could not add anything to that dialogue. However, I do have one question / comment that I don't believe has been addressed by others. The draft Shoreline Designation Map shows areas called "Potential Aquatic Conservancy" but the SMP document does not define the term. In fact, I believe that the term only exists on the map. Since I live close to one such area, I'm perplexed about what a "potential" designation means. Does the "potential" designation connote any restrictions on future use that would not otherwise apply to the area?

My formal comment, therefore, is as follows: The SMP should define the term "Potential Aquatic Conservancy" and describe any implications of such a designation.
