Dear Council Members,

I encourage you to ***delay*** adoption on the SMP until major changes can be made to address the following:

1. Change Nonconforming to Conforming for all legally-built homes and residential uses.
2. Eliminate the Shoreline Residential Conservancy and create one residential zone.
3. Restore water-dependent uses, such as docks, buoys, and stairs. And,
4. Restore the homeowner's right to choose which native vegetation they plant for mitigation, and drop the requirement for planting trees, which will harm our views and that of our neighbors.
