Dear Council Members,

I am a resident of the South Ward and your constituent. I am interested in the health of Puget Sound waters.

Perhaps such information exists, but I have not seen estimates of the relative amounts of pollution from Bainbridge Island, contributed by type of source, and ranked by level of damage caused, with the Bainbridge Island sources of origin (point & non-point) specifically noted.

It is my surmise that Bainbridge municipal storm water discharges may be our major contributor to pollution of Puget Sound but I have not seen its importance ranked against other sources.

If not already done by one of the Committees or staff, please ask the staff to supply such estimates **and ranking** to the Council for your consideration as you review the SMP draft and as you consider Bainbridge Island pollution sources that you will address under revised SMP's when adopted.

It would be helpful if such information (or lack thereof) could be published on the COBI web site for education of Island residents.

Thank you for your consideration of this request and your help to implement it.
