The "Draft" Shoreline Designations of Shoreline Residential Conservancy, Island Conservancy and Aquatic Conservancy prohibit water dependent uses for 70% of the Island – See the Black Line Map

Conservancy also makes existing water dependent uses, such as boats houses, docks, floats, buoys and stairs **Nonconforming**.

Every dock, float and boathouse in Fletcher's Bay, Point Monroe Lagoon, in portions of Port Madison and on the south side of Eagle Harbor including the Eagle Harbor Marina, Bainbridge Island Yacht Club, Eagle Harbor Yacht Club and a dozen private docks, would become **Nonconforming**. The sole purpose of making something Nonconforming is to eliminate the use over time.

Bainbridge should promote water dependent uses, not prohibit them.

Shoreline Designations should be rejected.
