RE: Eagle Harbor Sewer Beach Mains Project

Dear Property Owner:

This letter is to inform you that the City will be accessing the utility access easements located along the north shore of Eagle Harbor to conduct soil borings and test pit excavations in support of the Eagle Harbor Sewer Beach Main Replacement project.

Historical records show recordings of 15' utility access and maintenance easements for a majority of the properties abutting the north shore of Eagle Harbor; however, in some areas the soil borings may be conducted outside the described easement area, in which case, the City will be contacting each individual property owner to request access to the work site. The attached maps indicate areas where the proposed excavations are to occur. The work will be performed by City hired contractors and requires favorable tides to accomplish the excavations. Current resource data suggests that favorable tides will be present during the end of January and beginning of February time frame.
