City Moves Forward with Sound to Olympic Trail

Bainbridge Island, Wash., (January, 2017) – During their regular business meeting on January 10, the City Council approved awarding a construction contract to Nordland Construction to complete Phase 2 and Phase 4 of the Sound to Olympics Trail.

Construction on Phase 2 and Phase 4 of the Sound to Olympics Trail is scheduled to begin this spring. These phases will result in a shared-use trail from Winslow Way to High School Road along the east side of State Route 305. The project will also include a plaza on Winslow Way with a bench, as well as a boardwalk over environmentally sensitive areas along the SR305 corridor. The trail will be paved and 12ft wide up to the existing Vineyard Lane pedestrian bridge, and then 10ft wide from Vineyard Lane to High School Road. Construction of the trail is estimated to be completed by the end of the year.

At times during construction one or two lanes of SR305 will need to be closed for the project. The City will make more information on these closures available to the public closer to the scheduled closure dates.
