

## NARRATIVE

On 5/5/2025, at approximately 0804 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to the intersection of Madison Ave N / Wyatt Way NW for a report of a vehicle vs bicycle collision.

I arrived on scene at approximately 0806 hours. I observed one vehicle(Driver 1) stopped in the roundabout, facing north. Driver 1's left front tire was parked on top of a tan colored bicycle. Officer Colt Lasiner(829) was in the middle of the roundabout, tending to the bicyclist.

I contacted Driver 1 and obtained their information. Driver 1 stated she did not see the bicyclist at all until the collision occurred. Driver 1 stated she was traveling northbound on Madison Ave N when she approached the roundabout at Wyatt Way NW. Driver 1 stated there was a vehicle coming from the west on Wyatt that was traveling east into the roundabout. Driver 1 also stated there was a vehicle traveling south on Madison Ave N, approaching the roundabout. Driver 1 stated she slowed and waited for the vehicle traveling on Wyatt Way NW to clear the roundabout. Driver 1 stated as the vehicle cleared, she entered into the roundabout. Driver 1 stated as she entered the roundabout, she all the sudden collided with the bicyclist.

There was no damage to Driver 1's vehicle.

The bicyclist stated she was traveling from west to east on Wyatt Way NW when she approached the roundabout at Madison Ave N. The bicyclist stated she slowed and checked the intersection for cars. The bicyclist stated she felt she was clear to go and proceeded through the roundabout. The bicyclist stated as she went through the roundabout, she all the sudden collided with Driver 1. The bicyclist stated she did not see Driver 1 prior to the collision. The bicyclist stated she was having some lower back pain, but was able to stand and walk. The bicyclist was transported by Bainbridge Island Fire Department to Saint Michael's Medical Center for medical evaluation.

A witness to the collision stated she was traveling south on Madison Ave N, approaching the roundabout at Wyatt Way NW when she observed the bicyclist following closely behind another car in the roundabout. The witness stated that Driver 1 entered into the intersection and collided with the bicyclist. The witness felt the bicyclist was following the car in front of them too closely causing Driver 1 to not realize they were there.

An employee of a business located at the intersection of Madison Ave N / Wyatt Way NW reached out Officer Lasiner and advised him they had video of the collision. Officer Lasiner reviewed the footage. It shows the bicyclist enter the intersection, and Driver 1 fail to yield for the bicyclist, colliding with them in the roundabout.

Driver 1 was cited for RCW 46.61.290.3 Failure to Yield at sign/intersection.
