

NARRATIVE

At approximately 17:52 on 12/3/2024 I was dispatched by CENCOM for a report of an unknown injury collision in the area of 6969 NE Bergman Rd. I turned on my overhead lights and siren and ran code to the location. Upon my arrival I confirmed that nobody had been injured. I observed a large white box style truck partially blocking the westbound lane of Bergman Rd

The driver of the truck (Vehicle 1), [REDACTED], explained that he had been driving westbound on Bergman Rd and had swerved to the north side of the road attempting to avoid a vehicle that was driving eastbound on Bergman Rd that he thought he would have otherwise struck due to him being in a wide truck on a narrow road. The tire tracks showed that Vehicle 1's passenger side tires had traveled through the ditch on the northern edge of Bergman Rd, ultimately striking and uprooting a large stone/ concrete mailbox on the northern shoulder of Bergman Rd. The mailbox belonged to the owner of 6959 and 6969 NE Bergman Rd.
