

VEH 1 was traveling westbound on High School RD NE shortly after clearing the intersection with High School RD NE, and left the roadway, colliding with a tree. DEF initially made statements claiming that a road rage driver ran her off the roadway and she had to swerve off the road. Passersby in the area at the time of the collision did not see other vehicles leaving the area, but none of them witnessed the collision occur.

DEF had no apparent injuries and declined an evaluation by medics. DEF was wearing her seatbelt.

VEH 1 sustained severe damage to the front right portion of the vehicle, and the collision with the tree ripped the front passenger's side wheel off of the suspension. The wheel ripped off of the car was cracked in half from the collision.

DEF was unable to locate her phone to unlock the car for us to retrieve her insurance information and personal effects.

The tree involved was uprooted and knocked onto its side from the collision. The tree is on a city sidewalk, bordering a city street for the City of Bainbridge Island.

Officers arrived after Bainbridge Island Fire Medics had evaluated the driver, and believed she was intoxicated.
