

NARRATIVE

On 02/26/2025, at approximately 1523 hours, [REDACTED] reported her vehicle, a 2024 Audi Q8 E-Tron (license plate: [REDACTED]) had been struck by the vehicle behind her.

Upon investigation it was determined that while slowing due to traffic, the rear of [REDACTED]'S vehicle was struck by a red 2000 Buick Lesabre (license plate: [REDACTED] out of [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] had already exchanged information with the other driver, who provided her their license which read: [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was not on scene. I observed substantial damage to the rear bumper of [REDACTED]'S vehicle and she stated her children's car seats would need to be replaced. [REDACTED] provided me photographs of [REDACTED]'S number and license.

I contacted the number provided for [REDACTED] and a male voice identified themselves as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] confirmed he was in a collision near the intersection of State Highway 305 and Day Road NE. [REDACTED] confirmed he was driving and, "looked away" briefly before colliding with [REDACTED]'S vehicle. [REDACTED] stated he did not have insurance. Furthermore, [REDACTED] stated the vehicle was not registered in Washington and provided a picture of the vehicle registration and the front plate. The picture of the front of the car [REDACTED] sent me matched the photos [REDACTED] had taken. The registration described a 2000 Red Buick Lesabre (description matched the photographs taken by [REDACTED]), and listed: "[REDACTED]" as the registered owner.

Given that he admitted to driving the vehicle and that he did not have current insurance for the vehicle, I cited [REDACTED] for operating a vehicle without insurance and informed him he would receive the citation in the mail.
