## V2 was driving southbound on HWY 305 approaching the intersection with Hidden Cove RD. D2

and I interviewed her at her workplace approximately 30 minutes after the collision.

D2 stated that V1 turned eastbound on Hidden Cove RD, and that D2 did not see the V1 after she also turned onto Hidden Cove. This is also captured on the dash cam.

This is a hit and run collision, where D2 did not contribute in any way towards the collision. The video footage shows that V1 crossed the double yellow line, and pre-maturely entered the turn lane

stated she was intending to make a left turn to travel eastbound on Hidden Cove RD, when V1 cross partially into the oncoming lane of traffic to overtake her vehicle, and scraped the side of her car. D2 provided dash cam footage of the collision, which captured what D2 had told me. D2 was uninjured.

pickup. I was not able to locate the vehicle.

I inspected the damage on V2. V2 sustained light dentes and scrapes to the side and front panels of the vehicle, as well as scrapes to the front driver's side wheel. Most of the damage appears to be from the tires of V1 rubbing against V2.
