

## NARRATIVE

On 03/03/2025, at approximately 1659 hours, I was working uniformed patrol in the city of Bainbridge Island and was dispatched to the intersection of State Highway 305 and Winslow Way East for an apparent non-injury collision. Both vehicles were reported to have been parked in an adjacent parking lot.

Upon arrival I spoke with [REDACTED], who stated she was the registered owner and driver of the involved: green 2017 Honda Pilot (license plate: [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] vehicle had substantial damage to front bumper on the passenger side. [REDACTED] claimed that while she proceeded southbound on State Highway 305, in the left lane, she observed a yellow light for her lane on the traffic signal which controlled the intersection. [REDACTED] stated she made a right hand turn, towards Winslow Way East, when she struck another vehicle, which had entered the intersection, in the lane immediately to the right of the lane she was in. [REDACTED] stated this vehicle appeared to be travelling southbound, straight through the intersection towards Olympic Drive, where the ferry terminal was.

I spoke with [REDACTED], who stated he was the driver of the involved gray 2024 Volkswagen Atlas (license plate: [REDACTED]). The registered owner was observed to be: "[REDACTED]" I observed damage on [REDACTED] vehicle on the driver's side, just behind the rear driver's side door, near the bumper. [REDACTED] stated that he had proceeded southbound on State Highway 305, in the right lane, and observed a yellow light for his lane on the traffic signal which controlled the intersection. [REDACTED] stated he continued through the intersection southbound towards Olympic Drive, where the ferry terminal was, when the rear of his vehicle was struck while in the intersection.

The design of this intersection should be noted as follows. If one was travelling southbound on State Highway 305 towards Winslow Way, there are two undivided lanes. The leftmost lane permits traffic to turn left, right, or straight for local traffic, this lane is controlled it's own traffic signal. The turns allowed from this lane is indicated by a posted sign. The right lane is permitted for ferry traffic only and from this lane, traffic is only allowed to continue straight through the intersection, towards Olympic Drive. This lane is controlled by it's own traffic signal.

Based on the testimonies of both parties, it was not evidently clear what the causing agent was. The damage to both vehicles appeared to be consistent with both parties account of what had happened. Both parties declined medical assistance. No apparent injuries.
