

## NARRATIVE

On March 13th, 2025, at approximately 2027 hours, I was dispatched via CENCOM to a motor vehicle collision on State Route (SR) 305 just north of Lovgreen Road. Two different reporting parties called in. The first had reported that they had struck a deer, which sent it into the roadway. Another vehicle, unable to avoid the deer, also collided with it. The second caller, [REDACTED], pulled over onto Lovgreen Road just west of SR 305. I contacted her while Officer Miller contacted the other driver.

[REDACTED], who confirmed that she was not injured, said she struck the deer as it lay in the roadway on SR 305. That section of SR 305 is not well-lit, and [REDACTED] was unable to avoid the collision.

I looked at the front left area of [REDACTED] vehicle, a 2008 Volkswagen New Beetle bearing WA plate [REDACTED]. The vehicle's front bumper was cracked, and part of its grille had completely broken off from the impact. Underneath the vehicle, it appeared that several other parts sustained damage as well, although it was difficult to know the exact extent.
