

NARRATIVE

On 03/28/2025, at approximately 0942 hours, I was working uniformed patrol in the city of Bainbridge Island when I was informed via dispatch that a bicyclist had been injured on Sportsman Club Road Northeast, where the road intersected with Northeast Wardwell Road. I was informed via dispatch that no motor vehicles had been involved. Upon arrival, I was informed the involved bicyclist was in an ambulance, in transport to: "Woodward Middle School:" 9125 Sportsman Club Road Northeast, for further evaluation.

I arrived at "Woodward Middle School" and observed a female on scene, later identified as: [REDACTED], who held a black and red: "BMC time machine TM02" bicycle. I spoke with [REDACTED] who stated she was a friend of the bicyclist, later identified as: [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and a witness. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] traveled northbound on Sportsman Club Road Northeast, towards Northeast Wardwell Road, at approximately 30 miles per hour (judged by [REDACTED] vehicle speed as she was behind [REDACTED]), when she rode through a puddle and lost control of the bicycle. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] and her bicycle struck the roadway but no motor vehicles nor other objects.

I photographed the bicycle and uploaded them to evidence.com with the relevant case number.

I spoke to [REDACTED], who stated that as she travelled northbound on Sportsman Club Road Northeast, she glanced over her shoulder to check for traffic and then applied the brakes on the bicycle. [REDACTED] stated as she applied the brakes she lost control of the bicycle at which point she and the bicycle slid and struck the roadway.

I could not observe any visible injuries on [REDACTED] person. She was seated in the back of an ambulance with what appeared to be an emergency blanket over her lap. [REDACTED] was transported to the hospital by aid personnel and stated she had made arrangements for the storage of her bicycle.
