

NARRATIVE

On 12/08/2021 at approximately 0734 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to State HWY 305 NE/NE DAY RD E regarding a motor vehicle collision.

I contacted Driver 1 and passenger who stated they did not have any injuries. Driver 1 stated she was traveling southbound on 305 behind Driver 2. She was approaching the intersection of 305/Day RD when she saw a vehicle in the northbound lane have a collision with a deer. She looked back at the vehicle in front of her and saw it was stopping. She could not stop in time and rear-ended Driver 2.

I contacted Driver 2 who stated she did not have any injuries. Driver 2 stated she was traveling southbound on 305. She was approaching the intersection of 305/Day RD when she saw a vehicle in the northbound lane have a collision with a deer. She looked back at the vehicle in front of her and saw it was stopping. She was able to get her vehicle to a complete stop and avoided hitting the vehicle in front of her. She looked in her rear-view mirror at Driver 1 and was hoping she would get stopped in time. Driver 1 was not able to stop and rear-ended her vehicle.

Driver 1 appeared to have extensive damage to the front end of her vehicle. Driver 2 appeared to have minor damage to the rear-end of her vehicle. Both vehicles were still drivable and did not need to be towed. I took pictures of both vehicles and the damages. I later uploaded them into Evidence.com. I provided Driver 1 and Driver 2 a business card with the case number. I explained to Driver 1 she would be receiving a ticket in the mail for BI-10.18.010 Inattentive Driving and she stated she understood.
