Vehicle #1 had just offloaded from the ferry and was northbound on SR-305. As the driver of #1

passed through the intersection of Madison Ave and SR-305 she looked at her husband in the passenger seat, she had picked him up from a hospital in Seattle and did not see the slowing/stopped traffic on SR-305. She did not have enough room to stop before striking vehicle #2. Driver of #2 told me that he had been slowing for traffic and saw the vehicle coming up behind him.

NARRATIVE

He pulled to the right to try and mitigate or avoid the collision but was still struck. He and his wife were both complaining of soreness but after being checked by EMS they declined transport. Both drivers were given the case number to this incidence and referred to their respective insurance

companies.

Based on the statements, scene investigation and minor damage to the vehicles it appears that driver of vehicle #1 is at fault for the accident.
