NARRATIVE

On 12/14/2021 at approximately 1133 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to SR305/Madison Ave N regarding a two-vehicle collision.

I contacted both Driver 1 and Driver 2 who stated they did not have any injuries and declined any medical evaluation.

Driver 1 stated she was driving northbound on SR305 behind Driver 2. As she was approaching the intersection of Madison Ave N, she noticed the light had turned red, she started slowing down but got distracted by thinking about what all she had to do once she made it to Poulsbo and rear-ended Driver 2 who was at a complete stop at the light. She had damages to the front of her vehicle and hood. Her vehicle was still drivable.

Driver 2 stated he was driving northbound on SR305. The light at the intersection of Madison Ave N changed to red. He brought his vehicle to a complete stop and was rear-ended by Driver 1. He said that Driver 1 was not going very fast when the collision happened. The only damage to his vehicle is 1 of the license plate lights was missing on the rear end of the vehicle. He stated the vehicle is registered to the City of Bainbridge Island, it is on schedule to be taken out of service and is set to be auctioned off approximately next month. The vehicle is still drivable.

I took pictures of both vehicle's damages and later uploaded them into Evidence.com. I provided both Driver 1 and Driver 2 my business card with the case number. Driver 1 and Driver 2 swapped information on scene. I explained to Driver 1 she would be receiving a ticket in the mail for BI-10.18.010-Inattentive Driving. Driver 1 stated she understood and both vehicles left the area.
