

## NARRATIVE

Vehicle 1 was traveling west on Wyatt way and made the turn onto south bound Eagle Harbor DR. Tracks at the scene and damage on vehicle 1 show that it turned too far, crossed the oncoming lane and went off the shoulder. Vehicle 1 struck a fence post and a tree. The license plate for vehicle 1 and parts of the grill(matched) were found at the scene.

The owner of vehicle 1 states they were out of town during the window when the collision is believed to have occurred and that no one had permission to use the vehicle.

Vehicle 1 was located in the registered owner's car port unlocked with the keys placed in a container on the bench seat, where the owner says she always leaves the keys.

Vehicle 1 sustained moderate damage to the front end and FL wheel.

The fence sustained moderate damage and a string of lights were broken.

Property Owner believes the collision occurred around 0030 on 12/19 based on noises heard. He last saw his fence intact at 1800 hours on 12/18 and noticed it damaged at 0900 hours on 12/19.
