As he came abreast of the accident scene he saw that the female driving Vehicle #1 was a heavy set white female in her mid 40's. (Driver #2 provided a similar description) The witness jotted down Vehicle #1's rear plate as it left northbound from the scene.

While examining the scene I saw the debris from the collision was confined to the southbound lane indicating the impact was from the left of center vehicle.
