

## NARRATIVE

Vehicle 1 was traveling west on Koura RD cresting the hill at Fairmont LN NE.

As Vehicle 1 crested the hill, the driver and several passengers observed a deer in the roadway.

The driver of Vehicle 1 swerved to the right to avoid the deer, and went onto the shoulder.

According to the driver and passengers, the driver then overcorrected when getting back onto the roadway, causing Vehicle 1 to slide with the passenger side leading.

Vehicle 1 slid sideways approximately fifty yards, before the front end collided with an earth wall on the east bound shoulder.

Vehicle 1 rolled over and came to a rest facing east in the roadside ditch of the east bound lane.

The driver complained of back pain but declined to be transported by aid.

The front right passenger sustained head trauma and had an open wound. He was transported by aid.

The rear right passenger sustained injuries on her shins, she declined to be transported by aid.

The rear left passenger complained of no injury.

The rear middle passenger sustained a head injury and was transported by aid.

Vehicle 1 was towed by Kitsap Towing at owners request.

Vehicle 1 sustained massive damage over the entire body.
