

## NARRATIVE

Vehicle 1 was traveling north on Sportsman Club RD when they pulled to the north bound shoulder. Vehicle 1 collided with the mailbox for 7762 Sportsman Club, knocking it from its post. Vehicle 1 continued further off the roadway into the shrubbery of the same residence. The hedge stood approximately twelve feet tall and was six feet wide. Vehicle 1 completely entered into the shrubbery and climbed over the top of the end of it after traveling into the shrubbery approximately seven yards.

Vehicle 1 left part of their front bumper and their front right wheel well in the shrubbery. Vehicle 1 left their right mirror by the mailbox.

Vehicle 1 did not remain on scene.

The property owner exited their home several minutes after hearing the commotion, and Vehicle 1 had already departed.

Vehicle 1 was located at a body shop approximately thirty minutes after the collision was reported. Parts collected at the scene were matched to the Vehicle. Vehicle 1 had both right side tires flattened.

Damage to the property and to Vehicle 1 was photographed.

The Driver of Vehicle 1 stated that they collided with the property because they were distracted by Answering and reading text messages on their mobile phone.

The Driver of Vehicle 1 has been cited for operating an electronic device while driving.

The Driver of Vehicle 1 believes they were going 20mph when the collision occurred. They recalled that they did not brake.
