SUMMARY:

Officers received a report that there was a stop sign down at the intersection of State Highway 305 and NE Hidden Cove Rd. It appeared there was a hit and run to the guard rail which when hit had bent into the stop sign, dislodging it at the base. The sign had A WSDOT sticker on it, WSDOT was advised by CENCOM, report taken for the hit and run.

NARRATIVE:

On 12-3-2022 at approximately 1854 hours I was dispatched to the intersection of State Highway 305 and NE Hidden Cove Rd for a missing stop sign east of State Highway 305.

I arrived on scene to discover that the guard rail at the northeast corner of this intersection appeared to have been crashed into, which bent the stop sign and dislodging it at the base. I could see the stop sign just a little further down the embankment. This sign also appeared to have the Hidden Cove street sign on it as well. I noted that on the back of both signs there was a Washington State Department of Transportation sticker.

I requested CENOM notify and create a detail for WSDOT of the damage and to respond for the dislodged stop sign for repair. I noted various pieces of broken car parts, however none of them were intact enough to be able to determine the type of vehicle involved. There were no residences or areas close enough to the scene to have line of sight even if they had surveillance cameras or not. The reporting party only noted that the stop sign was missing, not that it had been hit, so the actual time of the collision is unknown.
