

NARRATIVE

On 02/07/2022 at approximately 1725 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to 206 Knechtel Way NE regarding a vehicle vs building collision.

The driver of Unit 1 clipped the northeast corner of the building when pulling out of the apartment's parking lot. Unit 1 broke two approximately 3' tall sections of 2x1 boards off the corner of the building. Unit 1 continued to drive away. Minutes later, Unit 1 returned to scene, a male got out of the vehicle, looked at the building's damage and then drove away again.

Later during my investigation, Unit 1 returned to scene. Unit 1 stated he did not remember or realize he struck the building. Both males that exited Unit 1's vehicle stated they believed the damage was already there. The fresh damage on the passenger side of the vehicle matched the fresh damage on the building. When I asked the owner of Unit 1's vehicle about the fresh damage to his vehicle, he stated that was not there earlier and he does not know where it came from.

Unit 1 had extensive damage to the back passenger door and fender. I took pictures of the damages to Unit 1's vehicle and the building and later uploaded them in Evidence.com.
