contributed equally to the cause of the collision.

VEH 1 was initially in front of VEH 2 as they approached the intersection with HWY 305 and Koura

VEH 1 and VEH 2 were involved in a collision as the result of a road rage incident where both drivers

DRV 1 had a passenger with a video showing VEH 1 returned into the northbound lane and crossing the double yellow line. DRV 1 insisted this didn't occur.

which was traveling slowly. DRV 2 stated VEH 1 entered the left turn lane on HWY 305, and then pulled back in front of her, before "brake-checking" DRV 2. DRV 2 then admitted to illegally passing VEH 1 on the right, using the shoulder, and "brake-checking" VEH 1 in retaliation.

DRV 2 said VEH 1 then attempted to pass her again in the no-passing portion of HWY 305 north of

DRV 2 was more forthcoming about the incident. DRV 2 explained that she was following VEH 1,

Koura RD, and DRV 2 said she accelerated to prevent the pass. DRV 2 stated that VEH 1 tried to reenter the lane anyway, and that is when their vehicles collided.

VEH 2 sustained very minor damage, VEH 1 sustained damage above the threshold.

The damage on both vehicles is consistent with the account given by DRV 2. The front right passenger's side of VEH 1 has damage showing the front fender was the initial point of impact, followed by the leading edge of the passenger's door.

I cited both drivers for illegal passing.

RD, both traveling northbound on HWY 305.

DRV 1 was unable to locate any insurance information, and could not recall who she had insurance with.
