

NARRATIVE

On 07/12/2022 at approximately 1105 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to SR 305/NE Seabold RD regarding a vehicle vs deer collision.

Upon arrival, I contacted Driver 1 and Passenger who stated they did not have any injuries and declined any medical evaluation.

Driver 1 stated he was driving southbound on SR 305, approximately 100 yards-200 yards North of the intersection of NE Seabold RD and a deer ran out in front of his vehicle. The deer came out of nowhere from the East side of SR 305 and was trying to cross over to the West side of SR 305. He did not have time to evade the deer and the deer struck the front left of his vehicle causing damages to his bumper, light, grill, quarter panel and hood. He said his vehicle is still drivable and he did not need a tow. When he struck the deer, it flew back across the road to the East side of SR 305.

I took pictures of the damages to Driver 1's vehicle and later uploaded them into Evidence.com. I provided Driver 1 and Passenger my business card with the case number. I located the deceased deer approximately 100 yards North of the intersection of NE Seabold RD partially on the road and I moved the deer into the ditch.
