advised Driver 1 was suspended in the third degree and had two outstanding warrants for DWLS 3 out of Kitsap County.

Driver 2 said he was driving home for work and was driving North on SR305 when Vehicle 1 pulled out from Hidden Cove Rd. Driver 2 said he braked as hard as he could, but it was not enough, and he stuck vehicle 1.

Driver 1 stated her she bought the trip permit from a friend for \$50. Upon inspection of the trip permit it was not valid due to it not being filled out correctly, are issued by WA DOL and not for transfer,

I cited the driver for DWLS 3, driving with no valid insurance, failing to yield right of way.

resale, or credits, the trip permit was invalid, and I confiscated the permit.

Both vehicles were not drivable and had to be towed from the scene.
