## NARRATIVE

Church RD regarding a motor vehicle collision.

Driver 1 stated she did not have any injuries and declined any medical evaluation on scene. Driver 1

stated she was driving southbound on SR 305 behind Driver 2. She saw Driver 2 slowing down for traffic but was not able to get to a complete stop before rear-ending Driver 1. She said traffic was

On 03/04/2022 at approximately 0817 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to SR 305/ NE Seabold

moving normal and then all slowed down very quickly. Driver 1 had extensive damage to the front end of her vehicle. The vehicle was not drivable, Driver 1's dad who is the registered owner arrived on scene and ordered a tow for his vehicle. I explained to Driver 1 she would be receiving a citation in the mail for 10.18.010 Inattentive Driving. Driver 1 stated she understood. I provided Driver 1 with my business card and the case number.

Driver 2 stated she did not have any injuries and declined any medical evaluation on scene. Driver 2 stated she is pregnant and will later seek medical evaluation at the hospital. Driver 2 stated she was

traveling southbound on SR 305. Traffic was slowing down in front of her. She began to brake to alert Driver 1 she was slowing down. Driver 1 did not slow down and rear-ended her vehicle. She drove across the northbound traffic lane and her vehicle came to a stop on the northbound shoulder of SR 305 facing southbound. Driver 2's vehicle had extensive damage to the rear-end and was not drivable. Driver 2 stated she wanted to go to the hospital to get checked out and ask if officers could impound her vehicle. I provided Driver 2 my business card with the case number. A friend of Driver 2 picked her up and transported her to the hospital. Officers impounded the vehicle per owner's request, the vehicle not drivable, on the northbound shoulder facing southbound and the owner not able to standby for tow. Kitsap Towing arrived on scene and towed the vehicle.
