

NARRATIVE

On March 5, 2022, I was dispatched to an unknown injury collision at Koura Road and Olympic Terrace. I responded code to the scene.

I arrived on scene and saw Unit 1 in the brush on the south side of Koura Road at the intersection with Olympic Terrace. The driver of Unit 1 stated a dog ran out in front of her and she swerved to miss it and was struck on the driver's side by another driver. I looked at the vehicle damage and roadway evidence. It appeared to me in my training and experience as a collision tech the vehicle was southbound on Olympic Terrace and was approaching the T intersection with Koura Road. Unit 1 missed the stop sign at Koura Road, continued south began a last second left turn onto Koura Road left the roadway and crashed into a tree and brush. There were clear visible passenger side tire tracks on the roadway and soft shoulder which supported this.

I do not believe there was any dog as this would not be how you swerved it would not be during a turn which directly leads off the road. There was absolutely no evidence of a collision with a second vehicle as this would have been on the driver's side due to the angle and traffic. There was not evidence on the vehicle that suggested a collision. Present on the driver's side rear was an old side swipe damage. I could tell this was old as it was slightly rusted and covered in the same dust which covered the majority of the car as it had not been washed in a while. There were fresh hand prints all over the trunk of the vehicle. I did not see inside the trunk of the vehicle to know what was in there or taken from there.

The driver of Unit 1 stated she was the driver of the vehicle several times and stated she was the only person in the vehicle at the time of collision.
