
NARRATIVE

Driver was driving north on highway 305 around 0345 hours. She stated she was going 65 mph in a posted 50 mph zone when deer ran out into the road and she swerved to miss them. The vehicle then struck the west side guardrail and launched over into the trees after barrel rolling a couple of times. She said she may have passed out but was unsure, but that there was a lot of blood. The vehicle appeared to have been airborne for approximately 25 yards after the initial impact with the guardrail. The length of when the vehicle hit the guardrail and when it came to a rest was approximately 80 yards.

When speaking with the driver, she said her shoulder and arm were in pain and she had many cuts and scrapes on her face and body, however she denied aid multiple times and went to the hospital with her boyfriend after the interview. She did not tell her mother that she was taking the car and requested the officer tell her mother about the accident.

Significant damage was done to the guardrail and debris was left in the bushes and ditch. Officers took photographs and uploaded them to evidence.com.

The driver was mailed an infraction for NVOL2.
