NARRATIVE

On 10/31/2022 at approximately 1528 hours officer was dispatched to State Highway 305 at NE Seabold Church Rd for a 2-vehicle collision.

Officer arrived on scene and all parties advised that they were not injured. Officer noted that vehicle one was parked behind vehicle two. Both vehicles were facing southbound on State Highway 305.


Vehicle one had damage to the front driver's side bumper and fog/turn signal lamps. Vehicle two had damage to the rear passenger side bumper, tail amp wheel well. Photographs of the damage were taken and uploaded to evidence.com.

Officer spoke with and identified the driver of vehicle one. She explained that she was traveling southbound on State Highway 305 and noted that vehicle two was stopped in front of her. She stated that she attempted to slam on her brakes, but she slid due to the road being wet and hit the rear passenger side portion of vehicle two. She stated that she attempted to turn her vehicle to the right which is why her front driver's side struck their rear passenger side. She also noted that she believes she was going 50 miles per hour. She advised that she was not able to stop in time once she saw that vehicle two was stopped.

NOTE* It was raining and there was heavy traffic on State Highway 305 at this time.

Officer spoke with and identified the driver of vehicle two. She advised that she was also traveling southbound on State Highway 305 but was stopped waiting for a vehicle in front of them that was waiting to turn left into the 14800 block of State Highway 305. She noted that she looked back and could see vehicle one before hitting her in the rear of her vehicle. There were two passengers in vehicle two.

Neither vehicle required a tow. The driver of vehicle one will be mailed a notice of infraction for driving too fast for conditions.
