NARRATIVE

At approximately 09:14 I was dispatched to a report of damage to a crosswalk sign at the intersection of High School Road and Madison Ave. N. Upon arrival at approximately 09:30, I observed the damaged crosswalk sign laying on the sidewalk. The sign was laying on the west side of the intersection of High School Rd and Madison Ave N on the sidewalk at the North end of High School Road.

I observed tire marks that originated from the intersection traveling westbound out of the roundabout and onto the sidewalk on the North end of High School Road. The tire marks led to the mounting base for the crosswalk sign, where a visible scratch in the pavement was observed where the sign

appeared to have been sheared off at the bottom and launched westward away from the intersection further along the sidewalk. The sign and equipment attached to the sign post appeared to be in serviceable condition, but the sign post itself was bent at the bottom.

I located several vehicle pieces scattered westward beyond the broken sign and in the westbound lane of travel as well. I researched the serial numbers and features on the vehicle pieces and discovered that they belonged to a 2013 or later model of Subaru Crosstrek, tan in color. Pieces recovered included a mud guard assembly, serial #: 59110FJ030, a broken piece of what appeared to

be the front driver's side bumper, as well as small broken pieces of what appeared to be a vehicle fluid reservoir and clear headlight cover pieces. Based on my observations of the scene, it appeared that the vehicle (Vehicle 1) had driven onto the side walk and struck the crosswalk sign with the

driver's side bumper.

CENCOM was notified and a request for repair for the sign has been sent to Bainbridge Island Public Works.
