

## NARRATIVE

On 9-22-2022 at approximately 1202 hours officer was dispatched to a non-blocking and non-injury motor vehicle collision at State Highway 305 and Sportsman's Club Rd. CENCOM advised that 3 vehicles were involved and were rear-ended.

Officer arrived on scene and pulled behind the 3 vehicles which were pulled off the shoulder of the road on State Highway 305, all facing in the southbound direction.

Vehicle one was the 3<sup>rd</sup> vehicle behind vehicles two and three. The driver was identified and explained that he was traveling southbound on State Highway 305 heading towards the intersection at Sportsman's Club Rd. he stated that he did not notice that traffic was stopped and was distracted, causing him to run into the rear of vehicle two. Vehicle one had damage to the right front bumper and grill but was still drivable. The driver stated he believed he was traveling at a rate of 35 miles per hour.

The driver of Vehicle one will receive a Notice of Infraction for inattentive driving in the mail.

The officer then spoke with the driver of vehicle two and the driver was identified. She stated that she had head and neck pain but declined an ambulance. She explained that she was stopped on State Highway 305 at the intersection at Sportsman's Club Rd at the red light. She noted that her vehicle was then hit in the rear by vehicle one causing her vehicle to hit the rear of vehicle three. There was damage to the rear bumper of vehicle two.

The officer then spoke with the driver of vehicle three and the driver was identified. The driver explained that he was also stopped on State Highway 305 at the intersection of Sportsman's Club Rd at a red light. He noted that it appeared vehicle two was also at a stop behind him, but then ran into his rear bumper. There was damage to the rear bumper of vehicle three and the rear windshield had been completely smashed out. The officer then could see the smashed windshield on the hood of vehicle two.
