

## **NARRATIVE**

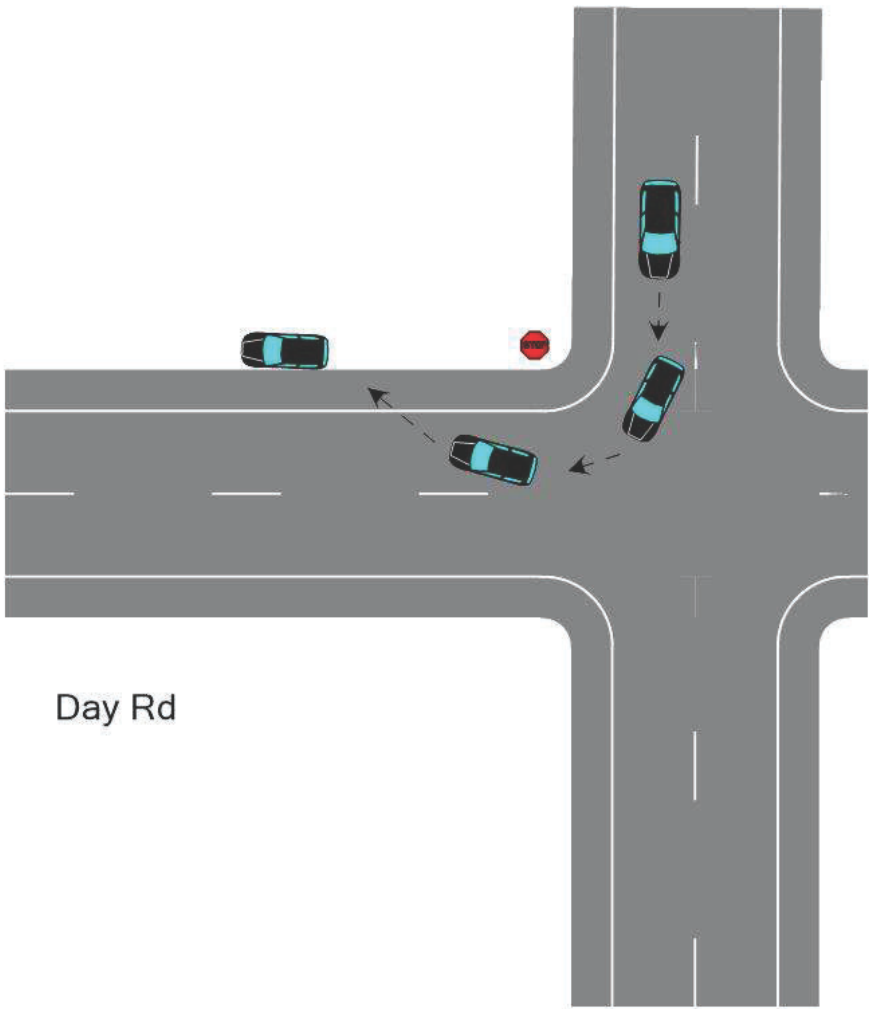
On 4/8/2023 at approximately 0714 hours, officers were dispatched to a collision at Day Road E and Sunrise Drive NE. The caller was a 3<sup>rd</sup> party who passed the incident and reported it.

The reporting party passed by a car in a ditch on the side of Day Road with 2 young females standing by the car on their phones.

The officers arrived and observed the vehicle on its side in the ditch, facing westbound off of Day Road. The driver approached the officers and identified herself. The officer talked with the driver and her passenger and to get their information. He thought he smelled alcohol coming from the driver's breath. The driver stated she was going too fast for the turn, over corrected and drove into the ditch on the north side of Day Road. When asked about what time this happened, she stated that it was around 0130 hours and went on to say that she was picked up by a friend who took her home. She stated she came back to check on her car and get it towed around 0700 hours. She was asked to call her parents, notify them of the incident, and ask to have the car towed.

The driver admitted to drinking at a friend's party, was asked to move her car, and instead decided to leave the party and go home. She stated she was going so fast on the turn that her keys slid off the seat and she reached out to grab them just before she drove into the ditch, also stating that she had wine at another friend's house after being picked up from the incident to calm her nerves.
