

NARRATIVE

On 4/25/2023 at approximately 1537 hours officer was dispatched to a non-injury single motor vehicle collision at SR305 and NE Manual Road.

Officer arrived on scene where vehicle was off the roadway of SR305 facing southbound crashed into a tree. The location was roughly 200-300 feet north of NE Manual Road in front of the access road to 14415 SR305.

Tire marks could be seen where the vehicle appeared to veer off the roadway and crashed into a slight ditch and then into a tree about 15 to 20 feet from the shoulder of the road.

The vehicle had extensive damage on all areas, air bags did not deploy. The vehicle did not appear operational and was going to require a tow and winch to be removed. The driver was contacted, was slightly injured and declined an ambulance.

When asked what happened, the driver advised that he had fallen asleep while traveling southbound on the highway on his way home. He noted that he had felt tired while driving through Poulsbo and was going to stop to get coffee but decided against it.

The witness noted that she had not noticed anything unusual as she was driving behind the vehicle and that it had suddenly veered off the road.

The vehicle had also struck the mailbox for 14415 SR305. The officer went to the residence to contact the homeowner and ended up leaving a business card along with the case number.
