

## NARRATIVE

Vehicle 1 was traveling south on Madison Ave, approaching the intersection with New Brooklyn.

Vehicle 2 was east bound, stopped at the stop sign where New Brooklyn intersects with Madison Ave. Vehicle 2 was intending to make the left turn to go north on Madison Ave.

Madison Ave does not have traffic control when it intersects New Brooklyn, and traffic continues through unimpeded.

Vehicle 2 entered the intersection, directly in front of Vehicle 1.

Vehicle 1 collided into the front left corner of vehicle 2.

Vehicle 1 sustained moderate damage and had to be towed from the scene.

Vehicle 2 was able to leave the scene under their own power.

No party involved claimed any injury at the time.

The driver of Vehicle 2 stated that they thought the intersection was a four-way-stop, and was looking to the right at a vehicle traveling north on Madison, that did not appear to be stopping as they approached the intersection.

The witness, was driving north on Madison Ave, and turning right onto New Brooklyn. The witness stated that they saw Vehicle 2 driving on New Brooklyn, and driving through the stop sign without slowing.

The driver of Vehicle 2 stated that they had stopped for the sign.

Both involved parties were provided with an exchange of information.

The driver of Vehicle 2 was cited for failing to yield the right of way to Vehicle 1.
