

## NARRATIVE

Vehicle #1 entered the intersection and made an unknown movement striking vehicle #2. #1 then fled the area in a south bound direction followed by #2 and the witness. Subject finally stopped at Country Club Rd and Fort Ward Hill Rd. The driver of vehicle #1 was profoundly intoxicated and was unable to stand without assistance. Officer R. Norton undertook the DUI investigation.

I spoke to the driver of vehicle #2 and he told me in broken english that #1 had struck him in the intersection but I could not determine how. The damage to both vehicles was the front driver's side. Emanuel, driver of #2, told me that he was going straight, indicating that driver #1 was trying to turn.

Followed up with witness who told me that he was westbound preparing to turn left onto s/b Sportsman Club when he saw veh. #2 just back from the stop bar heading N/B on Sportsman Club. He spoke to an unidentified couple on a motorcycle directly behind #2 who said the driver of #1 was fleeing southbound. The witness was able to catch up to #1 at Finch Rd. and Sportsman Club when #1 turned left onto S/B Finch. Witness said the driver of #1 took the left turn very wide to the point of being off the roadway and then overcorrected into the N/B lane of Finch. Witness continued to follow seeing a continual dangerous driving pattern. He said that it was so bad that he was honking his horn to warn others.
