

## NARRATIVE

On August 29th, 2023, at approximately 0752 hours, I was dispatched to an injury motor vehicle collision at the intersection of State Highway 305 and Day Rd on Bainbridge Island, WA.

I arrived on scene and observed two vehicles blocking the intersection of State Highway 305 and Day Rd. I arrived on scene and met with the driver of Unit 1, who was sitting on the corner with a minor laceration above her right eye. The driver of unit 1, which was a dark grey [REDACTED] with WA license plate [REDACTED], told me she was stopped at the Day Rd traffic light, headed Northbound on State Highway 305. The driver thought the light turned green, so she proceeded Northbound through the intersection of State Highway 305 and Day Rd and collided with Unit 2.

Unit 2 was a white [REDACTED] with WA license plate [REDACTED]. Unit 2 was travelling with four passengers in the vehicle. According to the driver of unit 2, they were stopped in the Southbound turn lane at the intersection of State Highway 305 and Day Rd. Unit 2 was turning Eastbound on Day Rd from State Highway 305. Unit 2's light turned green, and unit 2 continued to turn through the intersection, when they collided with Unit 1.

An independent witness told me he was stopped in the Southbound Lane of State Highway 305 at the Day Rd intersection. The witness said all Northbound and Southbound lanes had a red light. The witness told me he saw Unit 1 accelerate Northbound, through the intersection, and collide with Unit 2 as they were turning Eastbound on to Day Rd. The witness told me Unit 2 had the green arrow.

Unit 1 sustained extensive damage to the front end of their vehicle and was towed by Kitsap Tow.

All drivers and passengers were transported to St. Michael's Medical Center in Silverdale, WA for minor injuries.

Unit 1 was cited for 46.61.050, Failure To Obey a Traffic Control, to be mailed by the court as the driver was transported to the hospital.
