At the date and time indicated in this report, the driver of Vehicle 1, was traveling

northbound on State Highway 305 approaching the intersection of State Highway 305 and Day Rd. As the driver of Vehicle 1 continued northbound, they stated that they had glanced briefly down at

their phone and by the time they looked up they realized that the vehicle in front of them, Vehicle 2, had come to a stop due to a red light at the signal controlled intersection. The driver of Vehicle 1 collided with the rear end of Vehicle 2, resulting in minor injuries to both the driver and passenger of Vehicle 2 but no medical transport from the scene.

The driver of Vehicle 1 provided proof of registraton and a valid driver's license, but was unable to provide valid proof of current vehicle insurance. The driver of Vehicle 1 was cited for Dangerously Distracted driving, as well as for operating a motor vehicle without valid proof of insurance. I advised the driver that if they can prove that that did, in fact, have valid insurance in effect at the time of the collision, that the court may take that into consideration.
