NARRATIVE

On 12-12-2023 at approximatley 1508 hours I was dispatched to a motor vehicle collision at State Highway 305 and NE Day Rd. I arrived on scene and observed vehicle 1 behind vehicle 2 just north of the intersection on State Highway 305 at NE Day Rd, pulled over on the southeastbound shoulder both facing southeastbound. Both parties on scene indicated that the collision occurred a little further north of the intersection approximatley 75 feet from the NE Day Rd.

Vehicle 1 was a gray 2019 Dodge Caravan bearing WA plate: which had damage to the front bumper. Vehicle 2 was a black 2017 Ford Fusion bearing WA plate: which had damae to the rear bumper and trunk. The driver of vehicle 1 was identified as wia her WA State Driver's license. complained of pain to her legs and chest from the airbags deploying but declined AID. stated that she was wearing her seatbelt. The passenger in vehicle 1 stated her name was and that she was sitting in the front passenger seat, she also declined AID.

I asked what happened she explained that she was traveling southeastbound on State Highway

305 towards the intersection at NE Day Rd. She noted that traffic in front of her was at a stop so she attempted to bring her vehicle to a stop but her foot slipped off the brake causing her to crash into the rear of vehicle 2. I asked her far away from vehicle 2 she was, she stated roughly 2-3 vehicle lengths away. If she was 2-3 vehicle lengths away it would seem that she would have had enough time to react to the stopped traffic with her foot slipping off the brake.

The spoke with the driver of vehicle 2 identified as

Driver's license. complained of pain to her neck but declined AID. stated that her vehicle was at a stop for traffic due to the light at the intersection at NE Day Rd being red. She stated that she was hit in the rear by vehicle 1 and noted the crash felt pretty hard.
