

A pedalcyclist was travelling Westbound on NE High School road paralleling a 2018 Chrysler Pacifica. The pedalcyclist was in the designated bike lane wearing a helmet with their headlight engaged along with glow lights on their rear tire. The pedalcyclist said they saw Unit 2 slow down and start to turn on to Capstan Dr. The pedalcyclist pressed on the brake of their electric bike and realized the brake was not properly working. The pedalcyclist said they started yelling at Unit 2 to, "Stop! Stop," but the driver did not stop. The pedalcyclist said they put their arm out to brace for impact and collided with the vehicle.

The driver of unit 2, a 2018 Chrysler Pacifica bearing WA license plate [REDACTED], was travelling Westbound on NE High School Rd. The driver was turning right on to Capstan Dr NE, with their turn signal engaged, when they felt something hit the rear passenger panel of the vehicle. According to the driver, they did not see the pedalcyclist.

The witness said they observed Unit 2 go around the pedalcyclist at Grow Ave travelling Westbound on NE High School Rd. The witness said both the vehicle and pedalcyclist continued Westbound. The witness said they saw Unit 2 slow down to turn right on to Capstan Rd. According to the witness, the pedalcyclist did not appear to be applying the brake properly and collided with the vehicle.

The pedalcyclist was transported to St. Michael's Hospital with a left wrist brake.

Unit 2 sustained minor damage to the rear passenger panel of the vehicle.
