

## NARRATIVE

On 12-29-2023 at approximately 0659 hours I was dispatched to a single motor vehicle collision in the ditch at State Highway 305 and NE Day Rd.

When we arrived on scene the vehicle was located further northwest on State Highway 305 closer to NE Hidden Cove Rd. The vehicle was a black 2009 Chevrolet Avalanche bearing WA plate: [REDACTED]. The vehicle was facing northbound and was all the way in the ditch, wheels down and hazard lights on. The vehicle was unoccupied and it appeared that both side airbags had deployed.

Looking further southbound on State Highway 305 it appeared that the truck had veered off the roadway in the ditch a couple hundred feet up from here. There did not appear to be any damage to the vehicle aside from the passenger side mirror that hit a metal traffic sign pole, the pole did not appear to be damaged either.

Not long after, the driver and registered owner of the vehicle [REDACTED] arrived on scene, [REDACTED] stated that he was uninjured. [REDACTED] was not impaired and advised that he was driving northbound on State Highway 305 and was looking for something inside his center console and began to veer off the road. He noted that by the time his passenger side tire started to go off in the ditch it was impossible to get out and his vehicle just continued to sink in due to the muddy conditions from the wet weather.

[REDACTED] provided his driver's license, registration and insurance information for the collision report to be completed. My patrol vehicle printer was not working to provide him with an exchange of info (although no other party was involved) so I provided him with my business card with the case number. [REDACTED] advised that he would be calling for his own tow to get the vehicle out. The vehicle was not blocking so I taped it off in case we received additional calls.
