

NARRATIVE

On 5/4/2023, at approximately 1836 hours, officer was dispatched to Madison Avenue/Wyatt Way regarding a motor vehicle vs cyclist collision.

Driver 1 was contacted and stated they were driving southbound on Madison Avenue N. When they slowed down approaching the roundabout, they stated the roundabout was clear but saw an electric foot scooter approaching the intersection from the east. Driver 1 stated the foot scooter was on the sidewalk and they yielded to it to see where the scooter was going before entering the roundabout. Driver 1 stated the foot scooter did not enter the roundabout and turned right on the sidewalk to go north on Madison Ave N. Driver stated they entered the roundabout at a slow speed and immediately struck the scooter with their vehicle. Driver stated they never saw the scooter enter the roundabout. They put their vehicle in park, got out of their vehicle and checked on the rider of the scooter. Driver stated they asked the rider to stay laying down and called 911. The vehicle had minor scratches on their front bumper that may have come from the collision, but nothing looked fresh to the officer.

The scooter rider stated they were traveling westbound on Wyatt Way at approximately 15 – 20 mph. They stated they were in the roundabout and remembered being struck from the right side of their body, pushed on the center circle of the roundabout, and trapped under the vehicle. They stated they were wearing a bicycle helmet. They stated they were not injured but later learned they had an abrasion to their elbow and ankle. The bicycle had minor scratches on the front rack.

A witness was located who stated they saw the scooter driving westbound on Wyatt Way. The witness stated that Driver 1 was southbound on Madison Ave N, entered the roundabout and struck the scooter.
