NARRATIVE

On 5/10/23 at approximately 2126 hours, officers were dispatched by CenCom to Rolling Bay Presbyterian Church parking lot regarding a hit and run collision. A caller reported hearing a loud crash at the church and they ran over to find a vehicle speeding off, saw one of the wooden pillars for the church's awning was destroyed and there was a show left on the scene.

Upon arrival, BIFD was on scene, taped off the awning of the church with caution tape and contacted a church representative to inform them of the damage.

When contacted, the caller stated they were inside their apartment when they heard a loud crash sound. They stated they looked out their window and saw vehicle lights at the front of the church. They stated it looked like a vehicle was in the bushes in front of the church. They stated they could hear a vehicle revving its engine and sounded like it was stuck. They ran over to the church to see what was going on and saw two vehicles speed off and flee northbound on Sunrise Drive NE. They stated they did not have a description of the vehicles other than two sedans. They did not see the collision.

Officers contacted a witness on the scene. They stated they were north of the church across the street. They were standing outside of their vehicle and at approximately 2120 hours they heard a loud crash come from the church. They stated they heard vehicles revving their engines, got scared and got back into her vehicle. They saw two sedans speed out of the church parking lot and go westbound on NE Valley Road.

The caretaker of the church was contacted, who had not heard anything. They did an area check on the inside of the church and put up a temporary board to reinforce the awning.

Photos were taken of the damages to the awning, tire marks, and the shoe found at the scene.
