## **NARRATIVE**

On 5/27/23 at approximately 0049 hours, officers were dispatched to the scene of a vehicle collision with unknown injuries at 4404 Point White Drive. Dispatch advised of multiple reporting parties to a vehicle that had collided with a utility pole. Police and aid arrived at the scene of the collision finding no occupants in the vehicle or the area.

Officers arrived at the scene and observed a vehicle facing westbound on the north side of Point White Drive NE with its right side lifted off the ground. The vehicle's right side was lifted off the ground by a utility pole with the pole leaning on the car. Glass was observed across the road and east of the vehicle. The vehicle had substantial damage with most of its windows shattered.

Officers observed there were no occupants in the vehicle and that the utility wires in the area were hanging lower around the vehicle. Puget Sound Energy was informed.

Officer continued walking past the vehicle with a flashlight and observed a ditch with torn up grass and shrubs. With fresh mud in the ditch west of the vehicle. Mud was also observed on the roadway next to the vehicle. The vehicle's license number was recorded and CenCom was contacted.

The crash scene was consistent with a vehicle traveling higher than the posted speed limit, due to damage and length of crash scene.
