NARRATIVE

On 11/03/2023, at approximately 1325 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to SR 305 / High School RD NE regarding a motor vehicle vs cyclist non - injury collision.

Driver 1 stated he was on the eastbound side of SR 305 on High School RD NE pointed westbound. Driver 1 stated he was waiting to make a right hand turn onto SR 305 to go North. Driver 1 stated his light turned green and he proceeded to make his right hand turn onto SR 305. Driver 1 stated the Cyclist came out of no where and struck the front of his vehicle causing no damages. Driver 1 stated it appeared the Cyclist came from the East behind him and was trying to cross the road to the West. Driver 1 stated he never saw the Cyclist until they hit and he immediately stopped his vehicle. Driver 1 stated there was damages to the front wheel of the Cyclist's bicycle.

Cyclist stated he was on the eastbound side of SR 305 on High School RD NE pointed westbound. Cyclist stated he was waiting to cross the intersection to continue on High School RD NE. Cyclist stated the light turned green and the walk sign came on. Cyclist stated he proceeded to ride his bike across the intersection in the marked cross walk and Driver 1 turned into him. Cyclist stated he never saw Driver 1 until they hit and he fell off his bike. Cyclist stated there is damage to the front wheel of his bicycle.

A unknown male came on scene and showed officers his dash camera footage that captured the incident. The unknown male did not have the capability to get officers the video. The video confirmed what both Driver 1 and the Cyclist stated happened. Driver 1 had his right blinker on waiting for his light to turn green so he could make his turn. The Cyclist was on the sidewalk waiting for his walk sign to come on so he could cross the intersection. It appeared the Cyclist was offset from Driver 1's window. Driver 1 made his right hand turn onto SR 305 and at the same time the Cyclist proceeded into the marked cross walk where they stuck.
